Happy Nurses Week 2006!



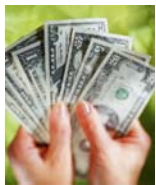

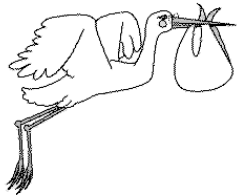

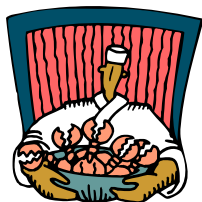
Feeling Crabby?
